WATER QUALITY REPORT

What is a Water Quality Report?

The Water Quality Report, also known as the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR), provides information on the drinking water quality of your water system for the past year. The Water Quality Report is required by the Safe Drinking Water Act and its amendments.

When will the Water Quality Report be available?

The 2021 Water Quality Report will be available after June 30, 2022.

How do I access the Water Quality Report?

The Department of Water Supply (DWS) delivers your Water Quality Report via the internet which takes advantage of technology to reduce paper consumption and preserve our environment. You can access your Water Quality Report by visiting our website www.hawaiidws.org/waterquality and clicking on **North Kona** on the Big Island map.
